School Fees 2023-2024

Student fees:

This year, we have changed our payment structure. We have <u>reduced</u> our student fees <u>from €370 to €200</u>. These fees allow us to best support your child when they are with us. Unpaid fees will result in no schoolbooks being made available to your child. Payment can be made at reception through our terminal or our website through Way2Pay. <u>All newly enrolled students pay €200 school fees</u>. A breakdown of these fees is given below. All outstanding fees will be followed up. We appreciate your support on this matter.

Breakdown:

- Student Levy €50
- Schoolbook rental: €85
- Insurance €15
- Journal €10

- Study Skills €10
- Phone Pouch €20
- Locker Rental €10

<u>Current students entering 2nd, 3rd year and 6th year will continue to pay the old school student levy fee of €120 or €200 per family until all students are on the new system as the school levies need to be covered.</u>

- 2nd year students: €120 school levy, €170 book fees (covers book rental 2nd year, 3rd year)
- 3rd year students: €120 school levy, €85 book fees (covers books for 3rd year)
- Transition Year: €300 total fees for the full year
- 6th Year students: €120 school levy, €85 book fees (covers books for 6th year)

Practical Subjects:

Students undertaking practical subjects incur and additional fee to cover the cost of materials. They are charged per subject, per term. The school year consists of 3 terms.

- Home Economics €20 per term
- Engineering €20 per term
- Wood Technology €20 per term
- Art €25 per term
- Music €5 per term
